In accordance with the Illinois EPA's Environmental Justice Policy, the Illinois EPA wants to provide you with information about a potential Illinois EPA action. The Illinois EPA is sending this letter to notify you of an application received by the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air (BOA).

The Illinois EPA has received a construction permit application from Tate & Lyle Ingredients Americas LLC requesting to construct a new carbon regeneration furnace at their facility located at 2200 East Eldorado Street in Decatur. The Carbon Regeneration Furnace is a furnace with an emission control system that includes a thermal oxidizer built on top of the furnace and a scrubber. The Carbon Regeneration Furnace is used for regeneration of carbon used in the clarification of several products.

The application is currently under review by the Illinois EPA's Bureau of Air.
